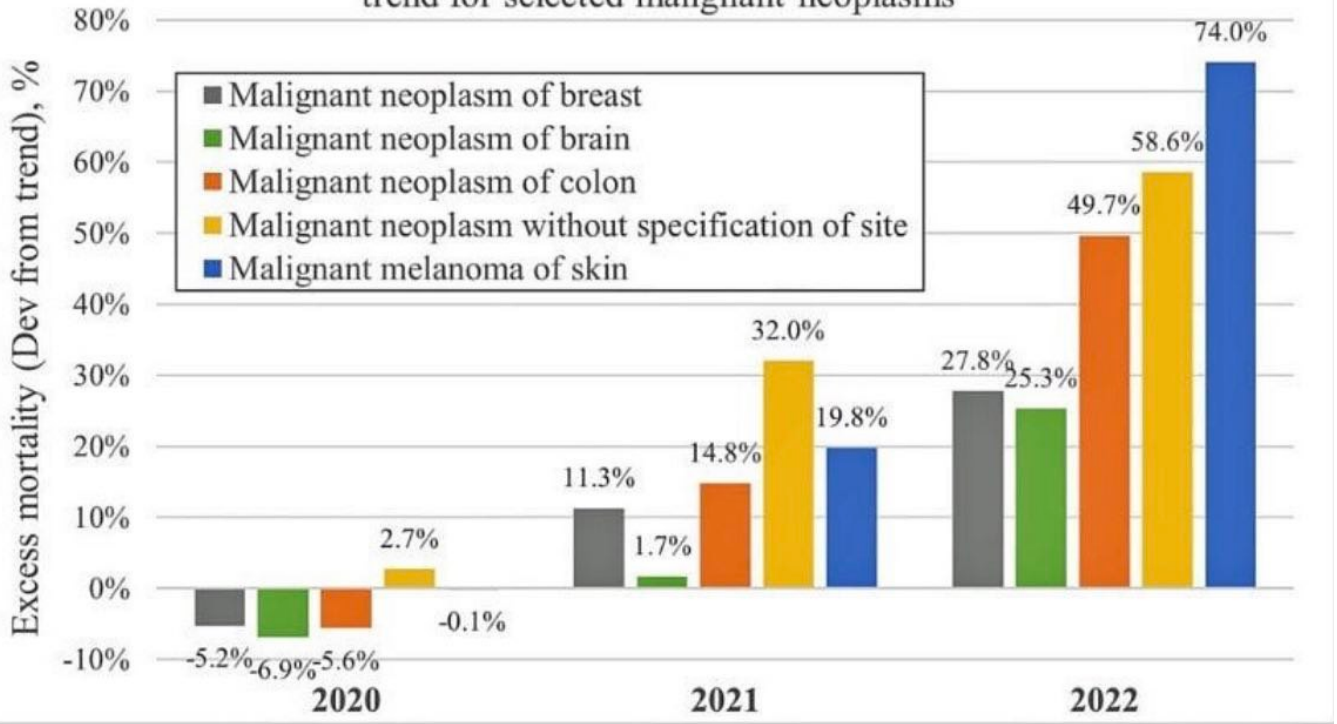


England and Wales. Excess Adj-Deaths (in percent) vs 2010-2019 trend for selected malignant neoplasms

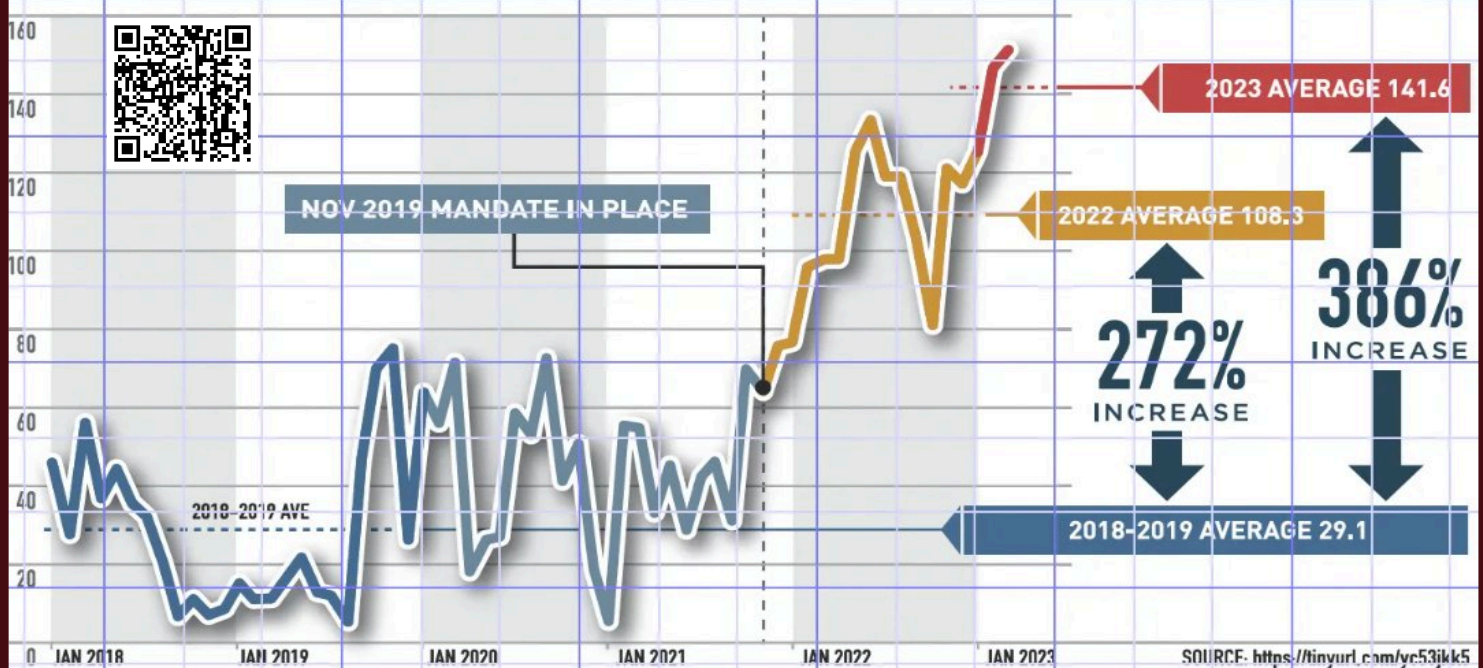

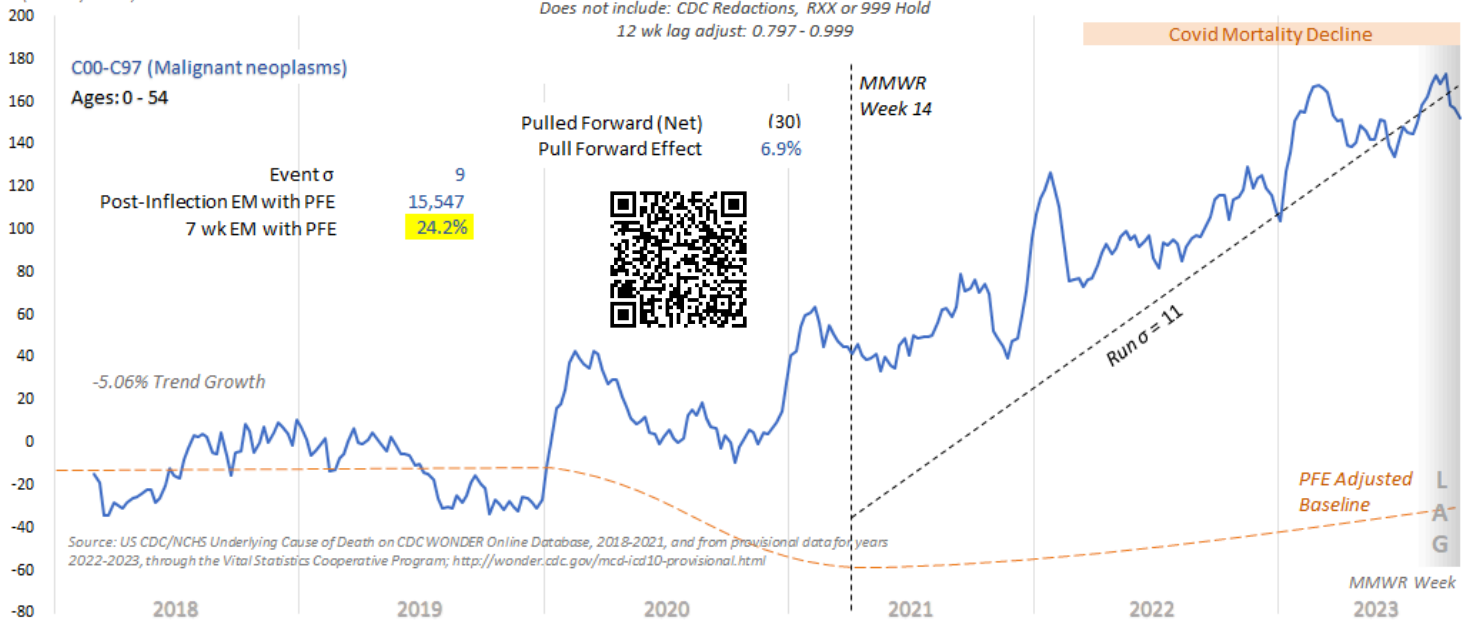
SQUAWK7700 ALERTS MONTHLY FREQUENCY CALLS 2018 - 2023



Mayday Flight Alerts up 272% in 2022 and 386% in the first three months of 2023. "There has been an unprecedented rise in the numbers of mayday calls as tracked by a bot set up by the X account @GCFlightAlerts It posts when a pilot squawks 7700 anywhere in the world.

Between 2018, and 2019, the mayday average was 29.1 per cent of all distress calls. During 2022, mayday calls increased by 272 per cent. In the first three months of 2023, the increase was 386 per cent. The graph shows there was an instant, steep increase when the vaccines were mandated to pilots."

2.13 Isolation and Quarantine Procedures

(a) Duty to issue isolation and quarantine orders

The government now has legal authority to remove residents from their homes and force them into quarantine camps. There is no age restriction. Children could be removed from their homes without parental consent. They do not need to warn citizens when they are coming or how long they must quarantine. You will be required to take any steps the state mandates, including taking medications against your will. There is no due process, no court hearing, and no rule of law as the government may now abduct citizens in the name of public health.

Coronavirus (Recovery and Reform) (Scotland) Act 2022

86G Special restrictions and requirements

(2) In relation to a person, the restriction or requirement referred to in subsection (1) is that the person—

- (a) submit to medical examination,
- (b) be removed to a hospital or other suitable establishment,
- (c) be detained in a hospital or other suitable establishment,
- (d) be kept in quarantine (within the meaning of section 39(4)),
- (e) be disinfected or decontaminated,
- (f) wear protective clothing,
- (g) provide information or answer questions about the person's health or other circumstances,
- (h) has the person's health monitored and the results reported,
- (i) attend training or advice sessions on how to reduce the risk of infecting or contaminating others,
- (j) be subject to restrictions as to where the person may go or with whom the person has contact,
- (k) abstain from working or trading.
